Admission Requirements

Applicants to the Health Studies Associate of Science online degree completion program must meet the following requirements:

- Have successfully completed a certificate program (at an approved post-secondary institution) with a minimum of 24 semester credit hours applicable to a health-related major or vocational program. (See chart for transfer semester credit hours/Carrington College semester credit hour requirements.)
- Have at least a 2.0 GPA.
- Own or have unrestricted access to a computer with reliable Internet access and an email account.
