About This Program

Carrington's Health Studies program, which culminates in an Associate of Science Degree, provides an opportunity for individuals to build on prior education to earn the educational credential that is often needed for advancement.

Offered in an online format, students in the Health Studies program enjoy the flexibility of attending school "anytime, anywhere" while continuing to work in their current jobs.

Prerequisite (Transfer) Coursework

Applicants to the Health Studies Associate of Science online-degree-completion program must meet the following requirements:

- Have successfully completed a certificate program (at an approved post-secondary institution) with a minimum of 24-semester-credit hours applicable to a vocational program or health-related major
- Have at least a 2.0 GPA
- Own or have unrestricted access to a computer with reliable Internet access and an email account

Per the Carrington College transfer-credit policy, students must complete at least 50 percent of the program requirements at Carrington College to earn a degree.

Degree-Completion Coursework

In this degree-completion program, students complete a broad base of general education course offerings focusing on:

- English composition
- Communication
- Computer literacy
- Mathematics
- Social sciences
- Humanities
- Science
- Critical thinking

Earning an associate degree via this online degree-completion option requires 30 to 36 semester credit hours of general education courses, depending on credits transferred. Students can complete the program in approximately 42 weeks (not including breaks).
