Respiratory care students at Carrington College establish a solid base of knowledge and continue on into focused coursework, hands-on clinical instruction and practice in a computerized simulation lab. The program includes clinical practice in which students apply their skills and knowledge to real-world situations in actual health care environments. Graduates are eligible to sit for the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) credentialing exams.* The program culminates in an Associate of Science degree.
